Welcome to the Department of Allied Health Sciences Professional Programs Application Website. The Application, Personal Statement information, and Recommendation Forms, are in Adobe's Portable Document Format (PDF). If you don't have Adobe Acrobat reader, then follow the instructions on the Allied Health Application Process page to download it onto your computer. The following are guidelines to aid you in the application process:

- Carefully read pages 2-4 ***Student Status for Application Process*** to determine your student status. Supplemental applications to other University Offices may be required depending on **YOUR** student status. This website has links to these offices for your convenience.
- ***Application Procedures and Instructions*** are located on pages 5 - 8 of the application.
- Only Application Forms from the year **2008** will be accepted. Applications from previous years **WILL NOT** be reviewed for admission.
- All applications become the confidential property of the Department and cannot be returned. The Department of Allied Health Sciences **WILL NOT** provide copies of the application or recommendations. Retain copies for your own records.
- There is **NO** application fee for the Department of Allied Health Sciences.
- **ALL** applications must be submitted by the stated deadline. Applications will be reviewed until all programs are filled.
- **ALL** transcripts, personal statements, and recommendations must be submitted by the stated deadline.
- Transcripts from other institutions **must be** official.
- UConn transcripts can be obtained via your Peoplesoft account. **INDIVIDUAL SEMESTER GRADE SHEETS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
- Incomplete applications **WILL NOT** be reviewed. Each applicant must submit:

2. _____ Two Letters of Recommendations (At least one letter must be an academic reference)
3. _____ Personal Statement (One for each program you seek admission to)
4. _____ Official transcripts of **ALL** academic work. Current UConn students may submit an unofficial UConn transcript (access in Peoplesoft)

Additional Applications (if applicable): Readmit and transfer applicants **MUST** be admissible to the University before the Department of Allied Health Sciences can offer admission to our programs.

1. _____ **Readmit Students:** Must submit a Readmission application through the Dean of Student's Office
2. _____ **Transfer Students:** Must submit a completed University Application to the Transfer Admissions Office.
